Benefits of Installing a Whole House Humidifier

Humidity is the second most important factor (next to temperature) in determining your home's comfort levels. That's why people feel much warmer and more comfortable in homes that use a whole house humidifier. - Prevent Illness:** Humidity allows tiny hairs in the nose to move and do their job of filtering out bacteria and viruses to prevent colds and flu. Added humidity can also help prevent bloody noses.
- Treat Illness:** Air moistened with a humidifier can help soothe some symptoms of colds or flu, including irritation of nasal passages, the throat and bronchial tubes, helping you breath and sleep easier.
- Moisturize Your Skin:** The heat blasting through your home during the winter months can leave skin tight, dry and itchy, especially skin on your hands, which have fewer oil glands. Lips also seem to chap more often and easily in the winter. A humidifier can help keep them moist.
- Reduce Snoring.** Low moisture levels in your nose and soft palate can increase snoring, so staying hydrated can be a big help. That includes drinking plenty of water, of course, but adding moisture to the air with a humidifier can also fight off dryness that can lead to snoring.

5. **Protect Furnishings:** Wood furniture and flooring responds negatively to too much or too little moisture in the air. Too little moisture can cause wood to split and crack. Adding humidity can help preserve the integrity of the wood.
6. **Create Warmth:** A humidifier will not only fight the dry skin that usually accompanies winter, it will also make your home feel warmer. The more moisture that is in the air, the warmer it will feel. Air with a temperature of 70°F and 10 percent humidity will feel like 67°F, but with 50 percent humidity, it will feel like it is 69°F.
7. **Control Static Electricity:** One sure sign of winter is the first time you pet the cat and get a jarring jolt of static electricity, or when you find the latest missing sock stuck to someone's shirt or pants. Dealing with an entirely different hairstyle is no picnic either. A humidifier can lessen the potential for static electricity.
8. **Hydrate Plant Life:** Many indoor plants come from tropical climates with high humidity. Indoor air does not always offer adequate humidity for plants to thrive. This will become apparent with leaves get brown or they die altogether. Adding humidity will make a difference for many plants.

A whole house humidifier is a great way to keep your family healthier in the winter months. They also have easy upkeep, you just have to check the filter once a month when you check your furnace filter and you don't have to keep them full of water since they are hooked directly to a water line.

- 1) **Aspen, Colorado.** Best time to go: Mid-September to first week of October.
- 2) **The Catskills, New York.** Best time to go: Last two weeks of September through mid-late October.
- 3) **The Berkshires, Massachusetts.** Best time to go: Late September to mid-October.
- 4) **Columbia River Gorge, Oregon.** Best time to go: Mid-September to mid-October.
- 5) **Green Mountain Byway, Vermont.** Best time to go: Second week of September to first week in October.
- 6) **Enchanted Circle Scenic Byway, New Mexico.** Best time to go: Late September to early October.
- 7) **Great Smoky Mountains, North Carolina & Tennessee.** Best time to go: Early October through early November.
- 8) **Upper Peninsula, Michigan.** Best time to go: mid-September to mid-October.
- 9) **Lake of the Ozarks, Missouri.** Best time to go: Last 2 weeks of October.
- 10) **Glacier National Park, Montana.** Best time to go: mid-October to early-late November.

Time Does Not Equal Money

Autumn Pumpkin Chili Recipe

This is a tasty fall-inspired pumpkin chili recipe which is sure to tempt even the most picky of eaters!

Ingredients:

1 medium onion, chopped
1 small green pepper, chopped
1 small sweet yellow pepper, chopped
1 tbsp olive oil
1 garlic clove, minced
1 pound ground turkey
1 can (15 oz) solid-pack pumpkin (not pie filling)
1 can (14 oz) diced tomatoes
4 1/2 tsp chili powder
1/4 tsp pepper
1/4 tsp salt

Optional topping: shredded cheddar and sour cream



Directions:

1. Sauté the onion and green and yellow peppers in olive oil in a large skillet until tender.
2. Add garlic, cook 1 minute longer. Crumble turkey into skillet. Cook over medium heat until meat is no longer pink. Stir in the pumpkin, tomatoes, chili powder, pepper and salt.
3. Transfer mixture to a 4 qt pot. Bring to a boil, stirring regularly. Once boiling, reduce heat and simmer for 30 minutes.
4. Serve with sour cream and shredded cheddar cheese as garnish.
