6 Common Air Conditioning Problems

If provided proper care and regular maintenance, a high quality air conditioning system can last for years. Sooner or later though, you will run into a problem with your A/C unit. Countless unavoidable factors like weathering, the age of your system & malfunctioning parts all wear down your system over time.

When an A/C system quits working, people tend to jump to the worst conclusion: "My A/C is broken for good and it will cost thousands of dollars for a new system." However, some problems are relatively minor, quick fixes that you can easily do on your own.

Of course, occasionally there are those critical problems that require the expertise and training of a service professional in your area. Learning how to tell if your air conditioning system has a minor or serious problem can save you lots of time and money.

We've come up with a list of 6 common air conditioning problems,

My air conditioner won't turn on.

Typically, there is one of three possible reasons why an A/C system won't turn on:

- Malfunctioning thermostat
- Tripped circuit breakers
- Damaged wiring

Tripped circuit breakers are easy. Simply check the breakers near your unit and carefully check for anything that may have tripped it. Once the issue is located, reset it and see if your unit turns on. If not, check to see if your thermostat is working. If not, or if the breaker trips again, you should call a professional. You likely have an electrical problem or failed component on your air conditioner.

Both air conditioners and furnaces are prone to making strange, almost frightening sounds when they get old. Some of these noises are normal for a functioning A/C unit, but others are symptoms of a bigger issue. For instance, vibrations or rattling suggests that the unit was incorrectly installed, dirty or out of adjustment.

The air conditioning isn't cooling properly.

The main reason why an A/C system stops cooling as it should is due to a dirty condenser or low refrigerant levels. Clogged condensers and evaporators can be cleaned on your own. However, A/C refrigerant can be toxic if not handled appropriately and each unit must have the exact amount of refrigerant as stated by the manufacturer's specifications, which is why you should **never add refrigerant yourself**.

My thermostat is reading the wrong temperature.

Your thermostat should have a sensor that measures the air temperature inside your home or office. First, check to see if it looks damaged or was accidentally bumped out of position as this could cause your thermostat to act sporadically.

The inside A/C coil is frozen.


A frozen coil typically suggests either dirty air filters, dirty evaporator coil, low coolant levels or clogged air duct returns. Changing the filter is easy and something you should do every month (...more or less often depending on if you have any pets or are prone to allergies). Low refrigerant levels or damaged ducts will require the knowledge of a professional.

My house has uneven cooling.

If one room in your home is always hotter or colder than the rest of the house, it means the air distribution of your cooling system is out of balance. Uneven cooling could also indicate damaged or improperly sized vents.


